<b>1. Mas de Vigneron Dry (France)</b> 	£2.90	£3.90	£10.95
Delicious, fresh, fragrant nose, followed by crisp green fruit 12%			
<b>2. Norte Chico Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)</b> 	£2.90	£3.90	£10.95
Full and pure flavours are matched by crisp acidity to finish 12.5%			
* Good with stir fried and spicy food, white meat and grilled fish			
<b>3. Montecelli Pinot Grigio (Italy)</b> 	£3.25	£4.25	£12.50
Delicate floral and fruity bouquet. Dry and fresh on the palate 12%			
* Serve with seafood and fish dishes, salads and cold meats			
<b>4. Broken Back Chardonnay (Australia)</b> 	£3.25	£4.25	£12.50
Clean and lively with lovely honey, apples and nutty flavours on the palate 12.5%			
*Goes well with seafood, cream sauces and poultry dishes			
<b>5. Martinez Lacuesta Rioja Blanco (Spain)</b> 			£14.95
A fresh rounded dry white wine with ripe peachy fruit balanced by crisp acidity 13%			
<b>6. Grand Cape Chenin Blanc (South Africa)</b> 			£13.95
A crisp, dry white wine displaying intense floral, guava and citrus aromas and succulent tropical fruit 13%			
<b>7. Ellie’s Cove Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)</b> 			£17.50
This Marlborough Sauvignon has fresh, crisp gooseberry, kiwi and passion fruit flavours 11.5%			
*Goes well with seafood, poultry and vegetable dishes and salads			
<b>8. Pasquiers Sauvignon Vermentino (France)</b> 			£13.95
Luscious exotic fruit aromas from the Vermentino are well balanced by clean, zingy Sauvignon 13%			
<b>9. Johnny Q Semillon Sauvignon Blanc (Australia)</b> 			£17.50
Clean, fragrant, grassy aromas with tropical fruit - a classy dry white 13%			

<b>10. Chablis La Colombe (France)</b> 			£21.50
This wine has toasty oak, buttery fruit then classic mineral tones and acidity balancing on the finish 12.5%			
*Goes well with fish, poultry and cream sauces, smoked salmon, king prawns and vegetarian dishes

A dry, fresh and fruity rose with delicate aromas of red berries 12.5%			
<b>12. The Old Station Zinfandel Rose (California)</b> 			£12.95
Light bodied and medium sweer, beautiful light pink in colour, packed with redcurrant and strawberry 10.5%			
<b>13. Casal Mendes Rose (Portugal)</b> 			£13.50
A light pink, refreshing and fruity rose with a light sparkle 10.5%

<b>14. Mas de Vigneron Red (France)</b> 	£2.90	£3.90	£10.95
A delicious medium bodied red with luscious plum and strawberry fruit on the palate 12.5%			
<b>15. Norte Chico Merlot (Chile)</b> 	£2.90	£3.90	£10.95
Ripe black cherry and plum fruit with a tad of tangy soy sauce. Quite soft but full and fruity 12%			
* Perfect with rich pasta dishes and red meat			
<b>16. Broken Back Shiraz (Australia)</b> 	£3.25	£4.25	£12.50
Medium bodied with ripe plum and spicy berry fruit flavours, well integrated with caramel 13.5%			
*Enjoy with red wine sauces, game dishes and red meats			
<b>17. Terralis Shiraz Malbec (Argentina)</b> 	£3.25	£4.25	£12.50
A delicious blend of two of the most noble red grape varieties with soft, succulent, berry fruit 12.5%			
<b>18. Martinez Lacuesta Rioja Tinto (Spain)</b> 			£14.50
A soft easy drinking style with purity of fruit and the spice indicative of tempranillo from Rioja 13%			
*Goes well with lamb, risotto, pork, ratatouille and grilled meats			
<b>19. Grand Cape Shiraz (South Africa)</b> 			£13.95
Soft and fruity showing black and redcurrants on the nose with good structure 13.5%			
<b>20. Flagtree Merlot Malbec Cabernet (Patagonia)</b> 			£14.50
Warm, ripe red fruit with jammy damson characters, gentle tannins and a rounded chocolatey finish 14%			
*Good wish steak, burgers and grilled meat			
<b>21. Siglo saco Rioja Crianza Tinto (Spain)</b> 			£17.50
The ever popular Rioja in the famous hessian sack, this is full, elegant and velvety smooth with good body 13.5%			
<b>22. Johnny Q Cabernet Sauvignon (Australia)</b> 			£17.50
Ripe fruit balanced with the sweet and toasted notes of wood. Soft palate, well structured tannins, leaving a persistent flavour 14.5%			
<b>23. 58 Guineas Claret (France)</b> 			£17.50
Medium bodied, perfectly balanced flavours of youthful red fruit with claret backbone 12.5%			
*Good with all red meats
